Uniforms for Pack 461

The Class A uniform is the formal, dress uniform worn at pack and den meetings, ceremonies, and certain public events. Uniforms can be purchased at the Occoneechee Scout Shop in Raleigh (3231 Atlantic Ave, Raleigh, NC 27604) or online at www.scoutshop.org/cub-scout-collection. The pack also has a limited collection of used uniforms. Please reach out to the Cubmaster if you're interested in this option.

The Class B uniform (the informal t-shirt) is for activities like campouts, hikes, or other events where the Class A uniform might get dirty or is less practical. The pack provides a Class B T-shirt when a scout first joins the pack.

For the Class A uniform, our pack only requires the Cub Scout shirt, but many scouts choose to wear the full uniform (see pictures on the following page). Blue shirts are worn in K-4th grade (Lion, Tiger, Wolf, Bear, Webelo) and khaki shirts with navy blue epaulets for the shoulders are worn in 5th grade (AOL). Uniforms should have the red numerals 461 attached on the left sleeve below the Occoneechee Council patch. An American flag patch goes on the right sleeve of all uniforms and frequently are sold pre-sewn onto the shirts. You can sew or use Badge magic to attach patches.

- The Pack will provide all rank advancement patches, belt loops, and pins as they are earned by scouts.
- Only the uniform shirt is required, but many scouts choose to wear the entire uniform as shown in the pictures on the next page.
- Scouts K-3rd grade receive belt loops to recognize their accomplishments and therefore might want to have a belt to show them off.
- Scouts 4th-5th grade receive pins to recognize their accomplishments and therefore might want to purchase the Adventure Colors ribbons to display their pins. It is attached to the uniform on the right sleeve under the American Flag.
